Instead, my intention was derailed by current events, the effects of which I had personally witnessed just the day before. And for the impact of my derailment on many of you, the faithful of Christ Church, I humbly apologize.

My wondering continues, and I look forward to conversations in the not too distant future about how and why many cultures and expressions of faith have moved from shielding foreigners from danger to distrusting foreigners.

Year of Transition

The **Search Committee** is diligently working and meeting weekly in person or by ZOOM. The rector search closed on **January 15**, **2025**.

Cindy Greene Horsmon passed away on January 3rd. We had a heavy snow storm on January 6. Thanks to Bart and his crew, the parking lots were cleared and the sidewalks shoveled for the Visitation for Cindy at Christ Church on January 8 and funeral on January 9. Thanks also to all who helped with parking both days and driving the golf cart; We had a large attendance for both the visitation (550) and funeral (300). Thank you to the Comfort Givers for providing the delicious reception after the service and thanks to all of you who helped with the service.

The Episcopal Diocese of Maryland, Southern Regional Council, will be having their quarterly meeting on February 7, with a spaghetti dinner at All Saint's Sunderland. This is open to all church leaders. Dinner starts about 5:30 – 6:00. Host church provides the spaghetti, and attendees bring salad, bread, or dessert to share. Christ Church will be hosting this on May 16, 2025.

In December, 2024, the Vestry created the Rector's Expense Fund (REF). This fund can be funded by specific donations and used by the Rector to pay non-budgeted expenses. We also have the Rector's Discretionary Fund (RDF) which is for the Rector helping those in need. The first Sunday of each month is when all non-pledged (loose) offerings go into the RDF.

The Vestry also discussed the Lenten Schedule as Easter is late this year. We will have the Pancake Supper on Shrove Tuesday, Ash Wed. Services, Soup and Bread Suppers after the Stations of the Cross on Friday's during Lent, Maundy Thursday Service, Good Friday Service at Solomons, The Easter Vigil on Saturday, No Easter Sunrise Service on the Tournament Field, this year, Easter Day Services will be at 8:30 and 10 am in the church. We will not have the Seder Dinner this year.

CALLING NEW VESTRY MEMBERS

Voting Members who are exploring a possible call by the Lord to Vestry service are expected to take full opportunity to prayerfully learn prior to the Parish Annual Meeting as much as possible about the duties, responsibilities, dynamics, challenges, and joys of Vestry service; please speak with any Vestry member or Officer. Election to the Vestry will be held at the Parish Annual Meeting on May 4, 2025. "Voting Members shall be nominated from the floor by another Voting Member at the annual meeting. No nominations for Vestry member shall be accepted unless the person nominated has agreed to serve if elected."

NOTE: "Voting Members: are persons at least 18 years of age who have been Ordinary Members for at least six months, and who are enrolled in this Parish, for the period aforesaid, as communicants-in-good-standing and as contributors. ("Communicants-in-goodstanding" have received Holy Communion at least three times during the preceding year and are faithful in corporate worship unless for good cause prevented, and in working, praying, and giving, for the spread of the Kingdom of God.) Also, the Safe Church Policy of The Episcopal Diocese of Maryland requires Officers and Vestry members to complete a criminal records check, a sexual offender registry check, a reference background check, and to hold training certificates from this Diocese in both "Prevention of Child Sexual Misconduct" and "Prevention of Adult Sexual Misconduct."

One way to show love is to do something nice for someone else. Luke 10:27 tells us to love our neighbors, but who are our neighbors? Everyone is!


Make these fun heart treats to share with some of your neighbors.

What you need:

- Saucepan
- 2 tablespoons of butter.
- 2 or 3 bags of miniature marshmallows
- 4 cups of crisp-rice cereal (regular or chocolate)
- 9 x 13 pan
- Heart-shaped cookie cutter
- Bag of chocolate chips (milk or white chocolate)
- Bowl
- Zipper sandwich baggie
- Scissors

What you do (with adult help):

- 1. Melt butter in saucepan and add marshmallows.
- 2. Stir until mixture becomes difficult to stir anymore.
 Mix in cereal and stir.
- 3. Butter the 9 x 13 pan and spread the mixture evenly in it. Allow to cool.
- 4. When cool, use cookie cutter to cut out heart-shaped treats.
- Melt chocolate chips in a bowl in the microwave.
- Spoon melted chocolate into a baggie. Cut off a corner and drizzle chocolate over the treats.
- 7. Enjoy giving a heart to your neighbor!


